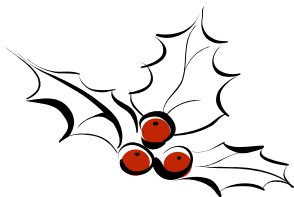




PTSA News

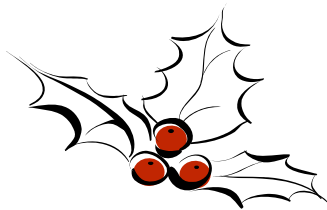


Dear Parents:
